Statewide Association

The State Highway and Transportation Employees Association of Missouri was organized in 1950 as a service organization to promote the general welfare of all employees, encourage the highest standards of employee conduct, and render the most effective service to the people of Missouri.



All Missouri Department of Transportation employees are eligible for membership in this organization. Membership is sustained with the payment of dues.

The Association acts as the representative of the members in presenting recommendations which will result in benefits and better working conditions for MoDOT employees.

Chapter 6 - St. Louis District Association

The current board for Chapter 6 was elected in August 2010.

The mission of the Chapter 6 Transportation Employees Association is to promote a local forum for networking, socialization, and discussion of pertinent issues for all D6 employees, and to contribute a representative voice for our district to the statewide Association's efforts.

Chapter 6 will be actively involved in fundraising efforts supported by the statewide Association and in disseminating information about issues that affect our membership, including relevant legislative topics.

Chapter meetings provide opportunities for members to learn and actively participate.

Delegates for the Association are allotted to each chapter based on representation of each 100 members. Currently, Chapter 6 is allotted 2 Delegate positions.



Membership Information

- Benefits of becoming a member of the Association include a \$1,000.00 accidental death life insurance policy, provided to a beneficiary of your choice.
- Membership dues are \$24.00/year and may be paid by single annual contributions or payroll deducted in the amount of \$1.00/paycheck.
- The annual membership fee supports both the Statewide and Chapter 6 Associations. Currently, the Statewide Association receives \$15 of each member's annual dues and Chapter 6 receives \$9.
